Greetings to our beloved supporters! Time seems to have flown by as we are currently finishing up our first furlough. Even though we are very ready to be back home, we are not ready to say goodbye again. We have enjoyed the last 8 months with many of our friends and family! Also, we are so grateful to all the churches that had us come in and loved on our family. I will never fully comprehend why God lets us do what we do, but I will forever be thankful! In our last prayer letter, I mentioned our 3 goals for furlough; and in this letter I would like to update you on the progress with these goals!

Furlough Update:

1. Property/ Building Fund: The Lord has brought in the full \$67,000 to purchase the church property and then \$7,000 toward the building! We are excited to get back, draw up plans, and prepare to build our church. From Guatemala we will continue to do fundraising, praying, and expecting God to use our support, supporting churches, and people to raise the remaining money needed for construction!
2. Support: The Lord has allowed us to get back to around 95% of our needed support! We trust God to give us the support He knows we need! Thank you to our new supporting churches, we are excited to represent you in the country of Guatemala!
3. Baby- Judah Stinnett Hill was born on April 19th! He was born with some breathing problems and spent 10 days in the NICU! We are thankful to report that he is doing good now, and all these issues have been resolved!

The Lord has allowed us to meet 1 of our furlough goals and make GREAT strides toward the other 2 goals. As God's children we often wonder "IF" God will really do the things He's promised to do! We even act surprised when God comes through in our situations! However, we should be thankful and confident that He is always FAITHFUL in His nature! What a good God we serve!

Since being in the United States, God has also given us many divine appointments to share the Gospel, especially with Guatemalan people! The other day I was out running some errands and decided to stop by a Guatemalan restaurant that had recently changed ownership. As I walked in, I was greeted in a manner of royalty. The staff was preparing plates and food to take pictures for their new menus. They told me to sit down and we begin to talk, all 12 of us. After 2 hours of sharing the Gospel and telling them how God sent us to Guatemala, I left with 2 young men, Chris and Wilmer, under conviction! Pray we will have another opportunity to talk with these people!

Family Update: I am overwhelmed by the goodness of God! Furlough has been an absolute blast, and our children have been encouraged and enjoyed their time with friends! Thanks to our parents, Melissa and I were even able to have a few day dates which we haven't had in 3 years! It has been a refreshing time, but as mentioned above, we are ready to be home!

IMPORTANT PRAYER REQUEST: I will be taking the 15-passenger van down to Guatemala on July 5th. This is about a 4-5 day trip and about 2800 miles. Please pray for my safety during this trip. Then, I will fly back to the states on July 12th, spend a couple of weeks with our family, then we will take our trip back home to Guatemala at the end of July or beginning of August! Thank you for joining us in prayer for these things; God is so good!
